Safety Rules for Hot Work

Obtain training on the risks and ways to mitigate them before performing the work. Use personal protective equipment, such as safety shoes, an apron, gloves, and a safety helmet.

- Ensure that the work environment and pathways are clear of obstacles and hazardous or flammable materials, and that the escape and emergency routes are clear and accessible.
- Ensure that all employees are familiar with the procedures in case of a fire and know the location of fire extinguishing and emergency equipment.
- Ensure that a special work permit is obtained for welding, polishing, and grinding work, and take all required safety precautions.
- Wash hands with soap and water at the end of the work and before eating, drinking, or smoking.



- Do not perform work without proper training on the risks, the method of execution, and the necessary means, materials, and tools for its execution.
- X Do not operate equipment without appropriate training.
- Do not block access to escape routes, fire extinguishing equipment, or the main power switch.
- Do not work alone in the work area; ensure that another person is present in case of an emergency.
- Do not work in confined spaces unless all necessary measures to mitigate risk have been taken.
- Do not attempt to extinguish a large fire alone. Declare the fire to warn workers and call for assistance
